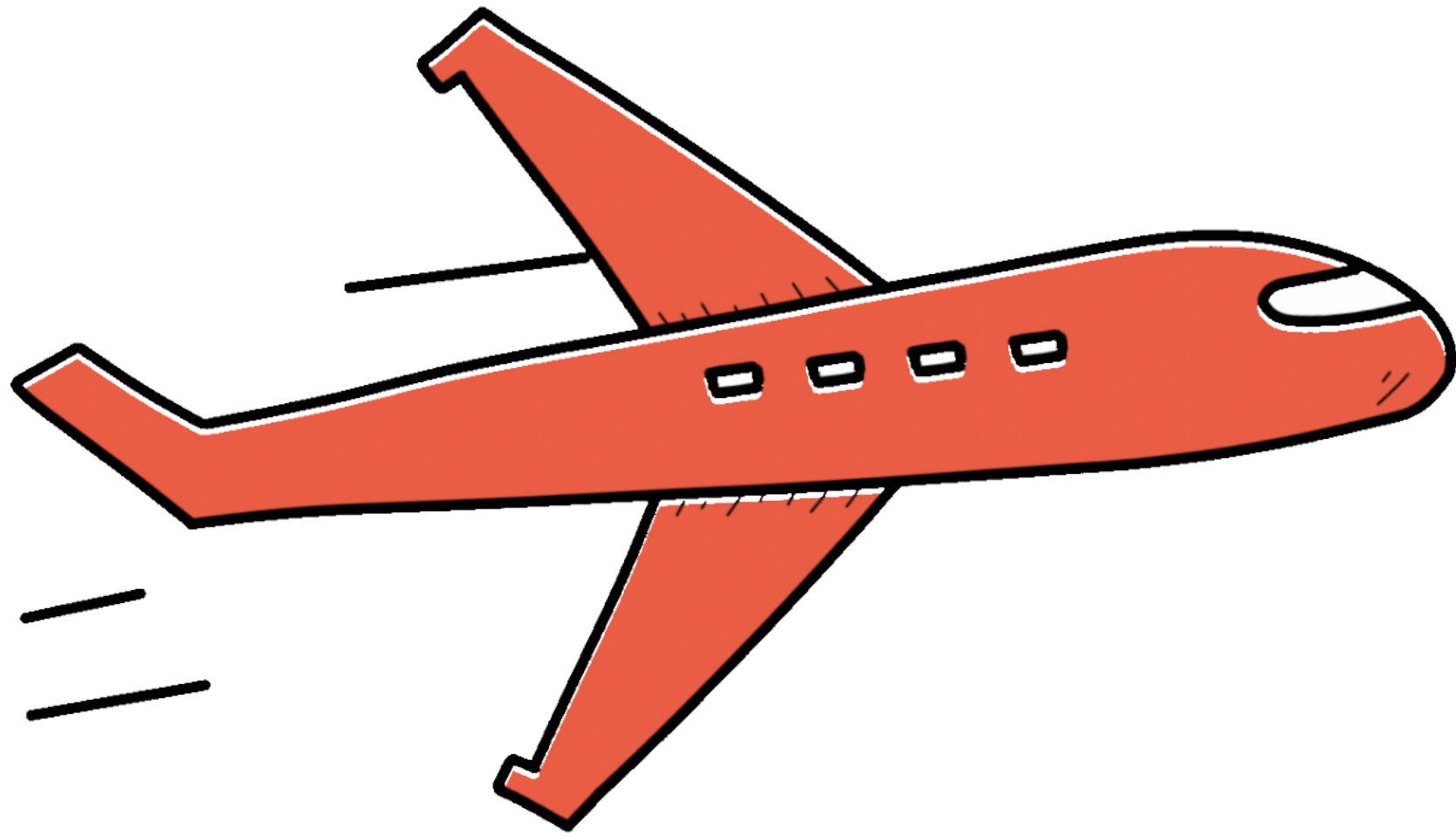


Alphabet



How to read & write Montenegrin (Latin alphabet)

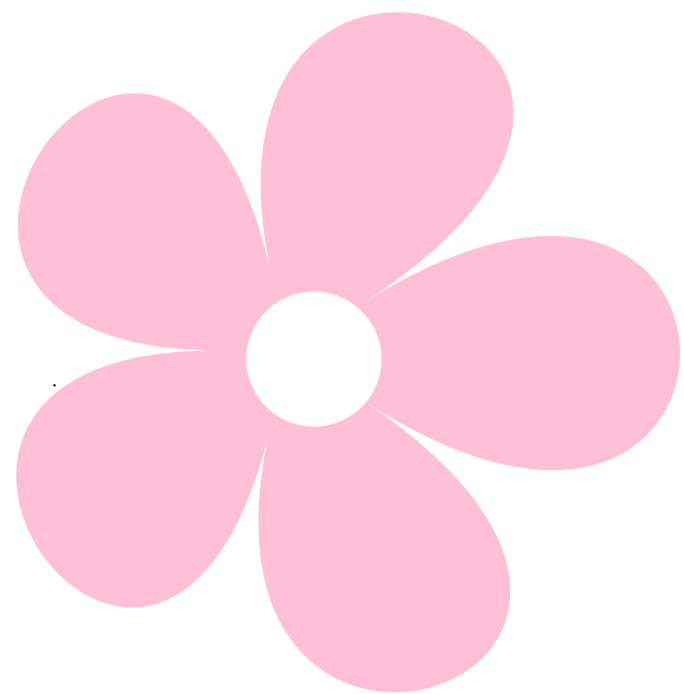
- Phonetic principle – every letter represents only one sound.
- “Write as you speak and read as it is written.”
- There are two scripts in use – Latin and Cyrillic.
- 30 letters = 30 sounds
